Petanque day – June 12th

Winchester will have its first Petanque day on June 12, immediately after the Farmer's market on the Winchester Green. The current form of the game originated in 1907 in <u>La Ciotat</u>, in <u>Provence</u>, in southern <u>France</u>. Pentaque is a game similar to boules or bocce, only played in a circle. Individuals or teams can play and the score is made of balls closest to the cochonnet, a white marker. A game is won by the first player to get to 13.

We'll have balls and instructors at the park on June 12, 1:30 to 3:30 and families are invited.
