- > Night In Amiens








Day 4: WEDNESDAY 06/10

> Visit of the Mine Museum in Lewarde






> Return to Saint-Germain-en-Laye

- Gala Dinner with Officials in Saint-Germain-en-Laye.










ROAD MAP SHOWING TOUR of Oct. 09 th

- The Imperial Heritage and the true home of Kings
- The Palace has been inhabited by all the crowned heads of France from the 12th to the 19th century (34 Kings, 2 Emperors) Museum Napoléon the 1st

Discovery of Barbizon, Painter's village

-The <u>Musée des Peintres</u> in Barbizon is settled in historic places like the auberge Ganne, where many artists stayed between 1820 and 1860, in order to find inspiration thanks to the surrounded nature. The inn was frequented by the first landscape painters, who ushered in the Impressionist movement.











Day 8: SUNDAY 10/10


- Cruise on the Seine & Oise rivers
