# DAY 1: SUNDAY 04/10

**Departure from Saint-Germain-en-Laye from Gare Montparnasse and journey to Vannes by TGV**




- ✓ Arrival at VANNES SNCF train station in late morning.
- ✓ Welcome by our professional Tourist guide and departure by comfortable coach for our exploration of Brittany.
- ✓ Lunch on the way.
- ✓ **First stop in Carnac:** Panoramic tour of the standing stones, undoubtedly the most famous site in Morbihan.



- ✓ Stop at an oyster farm with tasting: including 6 oysters and a glass of white wine.

# DAY 1: SUNDAY 04/10 (Cont'd)

- ✓ Arrival at your hotel in late afternoon in Quimper area, welcome and check-in.
- ✓ Welcome Apéritif

# DAY 2: MONDAY 05/10

## Day trip guided tour: Concarneau and Pont-Aven

- ✓ Breakfast at the hotel.
- ✓ **Travel to Concarneau** for a stroll through the walled city, the historic heart of the town.
- ✓ Visit the Fishing Museum.
- ✓ At the end of the visit, board a real retired trawler.
- ✓ Lunch during the visit.



# DAY 2: MONDAY 05/10

## Cont'd

- ✓ **Continue to Pont-Aven**, the city of painters, which once boasted "14 mills and 15 houses." Nestled on the banks of the Aven River, its charm captivated many artists in the 19th century, including the famous Gauguin.



- ✓ On our way : **Visit of a fish canning factory**
- ✓ Return to our hotel at end afternoon
- ✓ Dinner & night at our hotel in Quimper area

# DAY 3: MONDAY 06/10

## Guided Tour: Locronan and Pointe du Raz

- ✓ Breakfast at the hotel

Explore the charming village of Locronan, a "small town of character," with its superb cut-stone houses radiating from the beautiful central square and its well.



- ✓ Then depart for the "end of the old world," the **legendary Pointe du Raz**, via Pointe du Van and Baie des Trépassés. a jagged, impressive coastline.



- ✓ We will pass by the Eckmühl Lighthouse (entrance not included), which has just had its magnificent lantern restored.



- ✓ Return to our hotel in the Quimper area at the end of the day.
- ✓ Dinner and overnight stay at our hotel


# DAY 4: WEDNESDAY 07/10

## Day trip guided tour : Quimper and Le Guilvinec

✓ Breakfast at the hotel

✓ **Departure for a visit to QUIMPER**: a city of "Art and History"

✓ Stop at the Henriot-Quimper Pottery Factory, one of the oldest French companies established (everything is made by hand)



✓ Optional stop at a **biscuit factory** and its workshop where pastry chefs work and create traditional **fresh cakes such as Breton cake, far breton, and especially the delicious Kouign-Amann**.

✓ Lunch on the way

# DAY 4: WEDNESDAY 07/10

## (Cont'd)

- ✓ **Travel to the Port of Guilvinec** for a visit to the Fishing Museum or the fishing port, including a langoustine tasting.
- ✓ Guided tour of the various trades involved in the fishing industry: shipbuilding, boat maintenance, boat lift, and trawl repair. A fascinating and informative stroll along the quays.



- ✓ In late afternoon, watch the coastal trawlers return and unload their catch. Trawlers return (Monday to Friday from 4:30 pm).
- ✓ Then, enjoy a tasting of the famous "**Demoiselles du Guilvinec**" (langoustines) accompanied by a glass of Muscadet wine.
- ✓ Return to our hotel at the end of the day.
- ✓ Dinner and overnight stay at our hotel in the Quimper area.

# DAY 5: THURSDAY 08/10

## Day trip guided tour: The Pink Granite Coast


- ✓ Breakfast at the hotel.
- ✓ Departure for a journey across Brittany, heading towards the Côtes d'Armor and its superb PINK GRANITE COAST... (Perros-Guirec, Trégastel, Ploumanac'h...)
- ✓ Lunch featuring the local specialty "Kig ha farz" en route.




# DAY 5: THURSDAY 08/10

- ✓ Walk along the coastal path (GR34), a breathtaking landscape amidst the pink granite boulders.



- ✓ **Departure for our second hotel** at the end of the day in the St.Brieuc area. Check-in.




- ✓ Dinner and overnight stay at our hotel in the St. Brieuc area.

## Guided day trip: Dinard, St. Malo and the Emerald Coast

- ✓ **Then, head to St. Malo**, the Corsair City. Walk along the ramparts with breathtaking views of the sea, and visit the fortified city with our guide.

## Cont'd

### ✓ **Free time in Saint-Malô**




- ✓ Return to the hotel in the afternoon.

- ✓ Overnight stay at our hotel in the St. Brieuc area.


# DAY 8: SUNDAY 11/10

**Explore Dinan** and its charming medieval town with your guide. Let yourself be captivated by the charm of this birthplace of the Constable of France, Du Guesclin.




**Free time and lunch on your own** in the town.
